

3 Workshop on Administrative Management of Higher and Technical Education

Projected training dates: April 12–25, 2018

Application deadline: March 13

Duration of workshop: 14 days

Number of attendees: 20

Target attendees: Government officials from partner countries responsible for implementing policies of higher and technical education, middle and high-level executives of higher or technical education universities.

Eligibility:

- Age and experience: Applicants under 50 years old and with at least two years' experience in related fields will be given preferential consideration.
- Education: College degree or above.
- Professional competence: Applicants should have basic knowledge, including of the policies and regulations, of higher or technical education of their home countries.
- Language: Good command of English.

Information to be provided in advance: Application form

Information to be provided on arrival in Taiwan: Participant's report in PowerPoint or Word format, including the following content:

- An overview of higher and technical education development in your country.
- The current problems and challenges involved in promoting higher and technical education in your country.
- A case study of a successful or failed case.

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Introduction:

1. The workshop aims to:

- Enhance knowledge and skills in providing high quality higher and technical education.

- Assist partner countries in implementing industry-university collaboration and promoting youth employment and entrepreneurship.
- 2. **Assist partner countries in gaining comprehensive knowledge of Taiwan's higher and technical education through indoor lectures, field visits and seminars. The workshop focuses mainly on higher and technical education development, innovation and research, industry-university cooperation, and teaching quality assurance.**

Agenda:

- Indoor lectures: Taiwan's strategies on higher and technical education development, strategies on exportation of higher and technical education, trends and development of quality control system, and the Taiwan international cooperation forum on higher education.
- Field trips: Visits to universities and counseling units.
- Exchange platform: Participants will share the current situation of higher and technical education in their country, and present their accomplishments after having a common understanding on higher and technical education development through group discussion.
