- Professional competence: Applicants should have basic knowledge of local social development.
- Language: Good command of English.

Information to be provided in advance: Application form

Information to be provided on arrival in Taiwan: Participant's report in PowerPoint or Word format, including the following content:

- The latest information and conclusions from recent participation in international meeting/workshop/training in related issues.
- An overview of local social development in your country.
- The current problems and challenges involved in local social development in your country (Ex: Aging population in rural area, brain drain, or population concentration in urbanized area).
- A case study of a successful or failed case.
