These concepts will help small- and medium-sized enterprises align with global trends and develop sustainable production models so they can simultaneously boost resilience and competitiveness.

Objectives

- Strengthen waste management rules, encouraging producer responsibility and motivating consumer recycling
- Improve recycling efficiency with better secondary materials and reuse technologies

Contents

- Waste Management & Recycling Integration: Discuss policies for waste standards and integrated recycling, specifically those combining public services, community engagement, and a recycling fund, with emphasis on local government outcomes
- Resource Recovery & Circular Economy: Showcase Taiwan's consumer industry waste reuse practices, demonstrating circular concepts such as resource efficiency, sustainable design, and consumption pattern management

- How can businesses integrate material lifecycle management into existing recycling systems?
- How can governments incentivize businesses to incorporate circular concepts into product design and production?
